AGREED PROTECTIVE ORDER

On the \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, 2018 the Court considered the Application of MEKISHA JANE WALKER for a Protective Order.

Applicant, MEKISHA JANE WALKER, appeared by attorney James [REDACTED] and announced ready.

Respondent, [REDACTED] appeared by attorney Zachary [REDACTED] and announced ready.

The Court, having considered the pleadings and heard the evidence and argument of counsel finds that all necessary prerequisites of the law have been satisfied and that the Court has jurisdiction over the parties and subject matter of this cause. The Court finds that family violence did occur. The Court finds that the person who is the subject of this protective order, the Respondent, committed an act constituting a felony offense involving family violence against the applicant.

The Court also finds that family violence is likely to occur in the foreseeable future. The Court further finds that the following protective orders are for the safety and welfare and in the best interest of Applicant and Respondent and grants this Order, pursuant to Chapter 85, Texas Family Code and other applicable law.

IT IS ORDERED that the Respondent, [REDACTED] is prohibited from doing the following:

Committing family violence, as defined by Section 71.004 of the Texas Family Code;

**'Committing family violence against MEKISHA JANE WALKER, GRACE ELIZABETH WALKER, or any members of MEKISHA JANE WALKER'S household or immediate family;**

**Directly or indirectly communicate with MEKISHA JANE WALKER, GRACE ELIZABETH WALKER, or any member of MEKISHA JANE WALKER'S household or relatives in a threatening or harassing manner;**

**On the basis of good cause shown, from communicating in any manner with MEKISHA JANE WALKER, GRACE ELIZABETH WALKER, or a member of the family or household of MEKISHA JANE WALKER, except for communication with RYAN MURRAY;**

**Threaten a protected individual through another person or threaten a member of the family or household;**

**Going within 200 yards of the residence of MEKISHA JANE WALKER and ELIZABETH GRACE WALKER at [REDACTED] or at any address the protected individuals may reside;**

**Going within 200 yards of MEKISHA JANE WALKER'S place of employment, 1714 SUNSET BLVD, HOUSTON, TX 77005, or at any address the protected individuals may be employed;**

**Going within 200 yards of GRACE ELIZABETH WALKER'S school at [REDACTED] ELEMENTARY, [REDACTED] or at any school GRACE ELIZABETH WALKER may attend;**

**Intentionally communicate with MEKISHA JANE WALKER or any member of HER household or immediate family by telephone or in writing in vulgar, profane, obscene, or indecent language, or in a coarse or offensive manner, with intent to annoy or alarm the other;**

**Contact MEKISHA JANE WALKER, GRACE ELIZABETH WALKER, or any member of MEKISHA JANE WALKER'S household or immediate family;**

**Threaten MEKISHA JANE WALKER, GRACE ELIZABETH WALKER, or any member of MEKISHA JANE WALKER'S household or immediate family, by telephone or in writing, to take unlawful action against any person, intending by this action to annoy or alarm the other;**

**Place one or more telephone calls, anonymously, at an unreasonable hour, in an offensive and repetitious manner, or without a legitimate purpose of communication with the intent to annoy or alarm**

**MEKISHA JANE WALKER, GRACE ELIZABETH WALKER or any member of MEKISHA JANE WALKER'S household or immediate family;**

**Engage in conduct directed specifically toward a person who is a member of MEKISHA JANE WALKER'S family or household, including following the person, that is reasonably likely to harass, annoy, alarm, abuse, torment, or embarrass that person.**

**Harming, threatening, or interfering with the care, custody or control of a pet, companion animal, or assistance animal as defined by §121.002, Human Resources Code, that is possessed by a person protected by this order or a by a member of the family or household of a the person protective by this order.**

**Possessing a firearm or ammunition.**

**Destroy, tamper with, or damage any property of MEKISHA JANE WALKER, GRACE ELIZABETH WALKER, or MEKISHA JANE WALKER'S immediate family;**

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the license to carry a concealed handgun was issued to Respondent, [REDACTED], under section 411.177 of the Texas Government Code is suspended for the duration of this Order, if such license was issued.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that Respondent, [REDACTED] shall surrender the Respondent's firearms and ammunition to the Sheriff of [REDACTED] County, Texas immediately following this hearing and not later than 5:00 p.m. on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of July, 2018. **IT IS ORDERED** that the Respondent file a copy of the receipt for the transfer of the firearms and ammunition with the Court on or before 5:00 p.m. on the first working day following the surrender of the firearms and ammunition.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that RYAN [REDACTED] is excluded from inclusion in these orders. The Respondent may communicate with RYAN [REDACTED].

**ATTORNEY AND COURT COSTS**

**IT IS ORDERED AND DECREED** that Respondent, [REDACTED] shall be assessed a total of \$0.00 as attorney fees, at a fair and reasonable rate of \$200.00 per hour for the services of the prosecuting attorney. The amount collected under this Judgment shall be paid to the credit of the County Fund from which the salaries of the employees are paid are supplemented. Said attorney fees shall be paid on or before on the N/A day of N/A, 2018, by cashier's check or money order made

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED**, pursuant to Texas Family Code, section 85.007(b) that the Family District Court Clerk shall strike any and all information regarding the address(es) and telephone number(s) of the person protected by this Order, **MEKISHA JANE WALKER** and **GRACE ELIZABETH WALKER**, from the public records of the Court, and shall maintain a confidential record of the information for use only by the Court.

**NOTICE TO THE CLERK OF COURT:**

A copy of this Order shall be forwarded to the Chief of [REDACTED] Police Department, the **SHERIFF** of [REDACTED] County, Texas, the Constable of [REDACTED] County, Texas and **THE CONCEALED HANDGUN LICENSING UNIT**, Texas Department of Public Safety, Post Office Box 4143, Austin, Texas 78765-4143. The Texas Attorney's General's Office, P. O. Box 12017, Austin, Texas 78711-2017. On receipt of this Order suspending the license to carry a concealed handgun, the Department shall record suspension of the license, report the suspension to the local law enforcement agencies, as appropriate, and demand surrender of the suspended license from the license holder.

All said Protective Orders contained herein shall continue in full force and effect for the lifetimes of **MEKISHA JANE WALKER** and **GRACE ELIZABETH WALKER**.

**IT IS UNLAWFUL FOR ANY PERSON, OTHER THAN A PEACE OFFICER AS DEFINED BY §1.07, PENAL CODE, ACTIVELY ENGAGED IN EMPLOYMENT AS A SWORN, FULL-TIME PAID EMPLOYEE OF A STATE AGENCY OR POLITICAL SUBDIVISION, WHO IS SUBJECT TO A PROTECTIVE ORDER TO POSSESS A FIREARM OR AMMUNITION (18 U.S.C. §922(g)(8), §46.04, PENAL CODE.**
